JOB OFFER: POST-DOCTORAL position of 18 months at DAUPHINE UNIVERSITY

**SUBJECT**: APPLIED MICROECONOMETRICS, FAMILY ECONOMICS, HEALTH and AGEING ECONOMICS

The Department of Economics (LEDa) at Université Paris Dauphine PSL offer a post-doctoral position in economics. The position offers an opportunity to gain experience and develop research in applied microeconometrics, in a good environment with other European Universities involved in the project. The candidate will benefit from the support of a research assistant to help him with his research. The position also includes the opportunity of visiting in a European University of the HORIZON network, and the preparation for application for a permanent position, or a *Marie* Skłodowska-*Curie* Grant.

**Research description**: The research work is linked to the European grant Horizon Europe (2023-2026). This project is in collaboration with Elsa Perdrix (Dauphine University) Axel Börsch-Supan (Max Planck Institute, Munich), Daniel Barczyk (McGill University, Montreal), Matthias Kredler (UC3M, Madrid), and Sven Hougaard Jensen (Bruegel, Brussel). The project aims at providing a better understanding of long-term care arrangement in later life, in a context of arrival of the baby-boomers at an age at risk of dependance. The candidate is expected to work on questions related to the impact of family choice, labor force participation, and family arrangement (especially between siblings) on the provision of care for elderly individuals.

**Candidate's profile**: The candidate must possess (at the time of starting) a PhD in Economics. However, PhD students at the end of their PhD thesis are also welcome to apply. An experience with Stata is highly recommended. Good oral and written communication skills in English will be a key advantage.
